About the Auction

- Certain items will be designated for oral bidding on the night of the Auction. There will be no early bidding on these items.
- Silent bidding sheets will be available in the Social Hall for early bidding several weeks before the auction. Buy your bidding number and start your bidding early. Silent bidding is done by writing in your bidding number, name, quantity desired and amount of your bid (per item/person) on the next open line on the bidding sheet. Bids with no name will not be honored! Bids must be in increments no less than \$1. Watch the bidding sheets to protect your items!
- To raise your bid, **cross off your old bid** and enter your new bid on the next available line. Simply crossing out and replacing your original bid is invalid.
- Proxy bidding is allowed. You may ask a friend to bid on your behalf.
- The highest bid always wins. When there are multiple bids for the same item the Highest, Earliest bid wins so Bid High and Bid Often! You pay what you bid; there is no bid averaging.
- Results should be available a few days after the auction via mail. Winners and donors will be provided with details of their items. You may pay with cash or with a check made out to UUFH.
